
Editor's Note:

(YELLOW) and those that are still pending (RED) for the fraternal year.



FAITH (Clyde Slick) Complete 4 of the below **Building the Domestic Church** (COMPLETED) – purchase the kiosk and pamphlets for Our Lady of Leche Shrine and Prince of Peace Church in St Augustine. Cost of \$150.00

Retreat Day of Reflection (COMPLETED)- Scheduled for April 24th. This includes both Council members and men of the Parish. Father Pagano will be our facilitator.

Rosary Program (COMPLETED/ONGOING) – build on the rosary before each Council meeting. We also lead the recital of the rosary at all four masses for the Consecration of the Holy Family. A second completed action presenting Father David Ruchinski who oversees the Catholic Student Center at the University of Florida with 120 orange and blue macramé rosaries so graciously made by the Saint John Paul II Rosary Ministry.

RSVP Program to help Seminarians (COMPLETED) – we have presented a \$1000.00 to our own seminarian, George Gilbert. Cost \$1000.00 (budgeted).

First Communion (COMPLETED) – purchase Stoles for each Communicate. Cost of \$400.00 (new item/voted on/approved).

Catholic Student Center - (COMPLETED) - SJP II Rosary Ministry is completing at least 100 macramé rosaries for the Catholic Student Center at the University of Florida in their blue/orange colors for Father David. Cost of \$250.00 (not budgeted but approved by the members).


