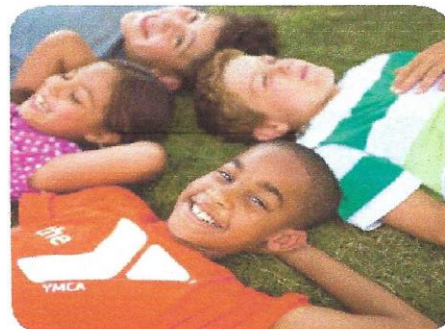

Every day, the individuals in our military make sacrifices to make life better for us. At the Y, we believe it is our duty to give back and support them. As an Armed Services YMCA Affiliate, we provide specialized programs and services for Service Members, veterans, and their families on the First Coast. Our goal is to help members of our Armed Forces and their loved ones come together, stay together and have the ability to adjust, bounce back, and thrive.

OPERATION HERO

Operation Hero is an afterschool enrichment program that addresses topics specifically relevant to youth in military families. The program provides a safe space for them to share their struggles and experiences. They discuss who they are and how they fit in at home and school, and how to manage feelings, friendships, and conflict. The sessions also include a period of homework assistance in areas identified by their classroom teacher, snack time, and an activity supporting the theme of the week.



OPERATION SALUTE: BACK-TO-SCHOOL BASH

The First Coast YMCA, in partnership with other community organizations and five other Florida YMCA Associations, in partnership with the Department of Defense, Building Healthy Military Communities Initiative and community organizations, hosts a Back-to-School Bash for up to 5,000 military and veteran families across the state.

In Northeast Florida, the Winston (Riverside), Brooks (Southside), Barco-Newton (Fleming Island), McArthur (Fernandina Beach) and St. Augustine YMCAs host up to 1,000 family members, providing backpacks and school supplies to school-age children.



FIT GAMES

FIT GAMES is an inclusive wellness challenge designed to encourage individuals to get active through fun and competitive physical activities. Individuals will strengthen their mind, body, and spirit through a variety of exercises and team workouts. FIT GAMES is set up to include all levels of fitness, with divisions for competitive, recreational, and recreational for Ages 50 & Better. Proceeds benefit military families on the First Coast.

OPERATION STRONG & READY

Operation Strong & Ready is a military wellness program designed for members of the Active Duty Component, Guard, Reserve, and the Delayed Entry Program to improve their physical fitness in a supportive atmosphere. Operation Strong and Ready will serve as a way to address issues related to our national security. The program strives to prepare Service Members to operate at peak performance and is designed to support their ability to pass their branch's physical fitness test. To promote healthy lifestyle habits, sessions will include weekly education topics covering nutrition, hydration, sleep, stress, tobacco and substance use.



CAMP IMMOKALEE

Every summer, kids have a blast at our resident camp, Camp Immokalee located in Keystone Heights. They discover who they are, nurture their creativity and imagination, and make new friends along the way. Camp activities include archery, arts & crafts, canoeing, zip lining, evening campfires, and so much more. Every Active, Guard, and Reserve military family will be awarded a scholarship. E1 - E5 will receive a 76% subsidy.

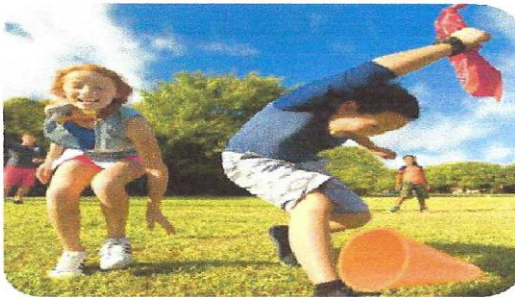
