ULTRASOUND DONATION - \$15K!



Knights of Columbus Council St John Paul II Council donates ultrasound machine to new pregnancy center

Knights of Columbus Council St John Paul II Council 16492 was the lead funder of an ultrasound machine for the Mayfair Women's Clinic, a faith-based pregnancy center in Jacksonville. The council and Florida K of C Supreme each contributed \$15,000 for the machine. Additional Councils of Coastal Laps for Life collectively contributed another \$3,000 for the ultrasound machine.

Mayfair Women's Clinic will use the new ultrasound machine to perform scans for pregnant women. "Ultrasound machines are critical to our work. Nothing is more convincing than the sound of that tiny heartbeat yearning for life," Executive Director Jeanette Ghioto said.

Of those planning on abortion, 86% will reverse that decision and choose to deliver the baby, either to raise it or give it up for adoption, according to Paul Gloekler, co-director of Coastal Laps for Life, who was instrumental in handling all the details for the donation of the ultrasound machine. The pregnancy center has also received a donation of a used machine from a donor, for a total of two machines.

Mayfair Women's Clinic embarked on its mission of rescuing lives by providing hope, compassion, and direction for pregnant women in crisis in December 2021. It has since been organizing and preparing plans to renovate its new facility at 1611 Mayfair Road.

The 8,000-square-foot building is being purchased and renovated to the center's specifications by an anonymous donor who will provide the building to the clinic rent-free. The center will have three ultrasound rooms, three consultation rooms and a chapel in addition to training and administrative offices. The center is seeking volunteers to help staff the clinic.

ESSAY CONTEST



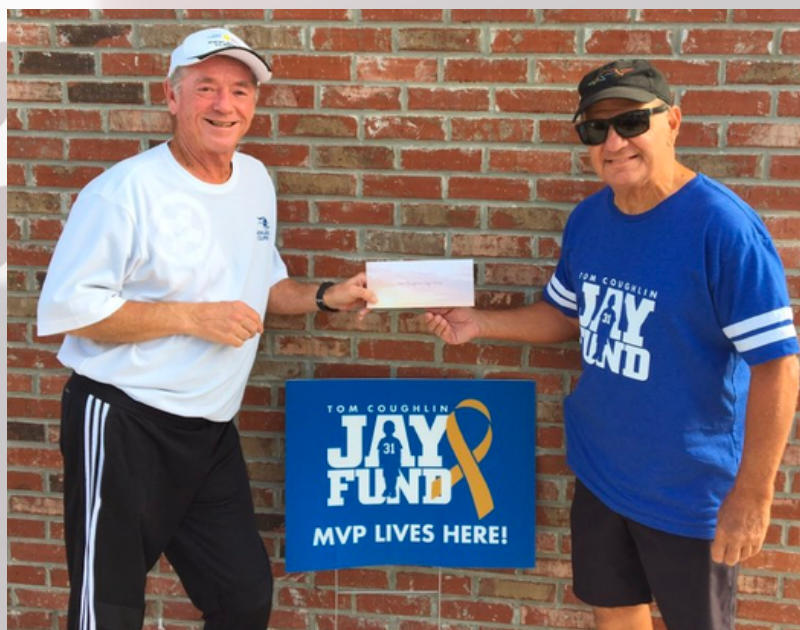
Led by our Community Director Joseph Pitisci, our council had 4 participants in the Catholic Citizens Essay Contest.

The founder of the Knights of Columbus, Father Michael J. McGivney was a central figure in the growth of Catholicism in America, and he remains a model today. His example of charity, evangelization and

empowerment of the laity continues to bear fruit and guide Knights of Columbus around the world. Just as those in need sought Father McGivney's help in life, understanding that he was a "Good Samaritan" figure, more than 2 million members of the Knights of Columbus and their families, and many others around the world, continue to seek out Father McGivney as a heavenly helper in times of need today. His heroic virtue was recognized in 2008 by the Vatican, which named him a Venerable Servant of God, and on May 26, 2020, Pope Francis approved a decree for a miracle attributed to his intercession, opening the way for Father McGivney to be beatified. The beatification ceremony will take place in the coming months. A second approved miracle is needed for him to be canonized as a saint of the Catholic Church. Those who knew him best in life saw in him both a "genial" countenance and a man with an "iron will" to achieve the good. In sum, his founding of the Knights of Columbus "attests to the love in which he held his brother man."
